Doug Kemp showed an assortment of pens from walnut, teak, bamboo, poplar, and cherry.



Dave Jones brought a natural edge bowl from a maple crotch and two small vases from spalted Jamaican dogwood.



Bill Smith completed a new three legged stool using the techniques shown by Kim Winkle during last month's meeting.

Irvin Jones turned a winged bowl made from an oak burl --



-- and also the decorated mahogany square bowl.

Bob Burford had three bowls from South American woods: the large one is achihua. The others are red milkwood and African mahogany.



Jerry Smith showed us how he lays out, carves, and sands the feet on these wonderful vessels. He also showed his process for finishing. These two bowls are hickory and cherry. Thanks for a great program, Jerry!
